OUR CURRICULUM

The Cherry Tree Curriculum has been designed specifically for our children, to help them understand their world, and to enable them to reflect on how they can contribute to the local and global community.

Our Outside Education Programme offers all children the opportunity to explore, discover and interact with nature in the safety of our beautiful school grounds. Outdoor sessions are linked to the topics being investigated in the classroom to complement and broaden the children's learning.

Forest School is very much part of this holistic outlook of our school and specifically provides opportunities for our children to develop valuable life skills, confidence and a growth mindset that will benefit them beyond their primary years.



EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE

At Cherry Tree, ensuring a child's learning is fun, purposeful and engaging is essential.

In our Early Years, there are plenty of opportunities for independent, group and whole class learning during the day which are based both in the classroom and outdoors.

Our curriculum ensures children become independent and curious young learners and flourish as they take a journey through their education.

Our beliefs and promises are woven through our curriculum to provide a firm foundation on which our children can 'learn together' and 'learn for life!'.



HOME LEARNING

Home learning provides children with opportunities to enhance and practice their learning or study their skills.

This may take the form of shared reading; spellings or times tables to learn; individual research for a topic and may reflect any aspect of the curriculum.

Children will be given instructions about how to complete their learning before they take it home but parent co-operation is encouraged in assisting their child to develop a responsible attitude to home learning.

At the end of each half term, we hold 'Open Classroom' celebration sessions to share the hard work of our pupils.

CLUBS

There are plenty of opportunities to join one of our many before or after school clubs. Examples of clubs include Football, Gymnastics, Gardening, Coding, Sewing, Maths, Multi-Skills, and Street Dance. Our Sunrise and Sunset Clubs operate from 07:30 - 08:45 and 15:15 - 18:00 (17:30 on Fridays) to provide parents with wrap-around care. Details of the clubs are publicised on our website.

We pride ourselves on being approachable. Teachers are happy to talk with you before or after school and can answer more in depth enquiries by telephone or an appointment in person. We write fortnightly newsletters and additional email communication when needed as well as showcasing learning on social media.





PASTORAL CARE

At Cherry Tree we truly care about our pupils, their families and our community.

Our pastoral team support children and their families in the following ways:

- Bonnie sessions (our Dog Mentor)
- Social and welfare support

The team work with external agencies and alongside families to reach the best outcomes for our children. They work with children in school to help them access all aspects of school life: learning, social, play and achieving greater emotional resilience.

Bonnie our school dog also supports with this and works with her trained 'Dog Mentors' three times per week. She's very much a part of our school community.
