OUR CURRICULUM

The Cherry Tree Curriculum has been designed specifically for our children, to help them understand their world, and to enable them to progressively reflect on how they can contribute to the local and global community.

Our Outside Education Programme offers all children the opportunity to explore, discover and interact with nature in the safety of our beautiful school grounds. Outdoor sessions are linked to the topics being investigated in the classroom to complement and broaden the children's learning.

Forest School is very much part of this holistic outlook of our school and specifically provides wonderful opportunities for our children to develop valuable life skills, confidence and a growth mindset that will benefit them throughout their lives.



EARLY YEARS FOUNDATION STAGE

At Cherry Tree, ensuring a child's learning is fun, purposeful and engaging is essential.

In our early years, there are plenty of opportunities for independent, group and whole class learning during the day which are based both in the classroom and outdoors.

Our curriculum ensures children become independent and inquisitive young learners and flourish as they take a journey through their education.

Our beliefs and promises are woven through the curriculum to provide a firm foundation on which our children can 'learn together and learn for life'.



HOME LEARNING

Homework provides children with opportunities to enhance and practice their learning or study skills.

This may take the form of shared reading; spellings or tables to learn; individual research for a topic and may reflect any aspect of the curriculum.

Children will be given instructions about how to do the work before they take it home but parent cooperation is encouraged in assisting their child to develop a responsible attitude to homework.
