## Day One Learning Objective: Phonics/Mark making/Maths Find things around your house/garden that begin with the 'o' sound. Practice saying the 'o' sound with the Jolly phonics action. Trace the letter that makes the 'o' sound up in the air, on the floor, in your palm, on each other's back. (this will be a bit tickly). Then try to write the letter 'o' on a paper, this is a bit tricky, so use the letter formation sheets at the end. Challenge: How many objects starting with the 'o' sound did you find? Try to write the number using the number formation sheet. orange onion oil olives origami ostrich otter (Tune: Old MacDonald Track 14) Now it's dark, the lights go on. 101-101-101-101-101. ### Learning Objective: Literacy - Owl Babies


Listen to the story of 'Owl Babies' or read the book if you have a copy of it. (This story has been chosen to get ready to move into a new class and go back to school)

## Day Three

Learning Objective: Maths - Time

Today we are going to play a game - What's the time Mr Wolf?

You could make a pretend clock to play this game.

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- 1. Child goes to one end of the room/garden and the adult at the other end.
- 2. Adult says, "What's the time Mr Wolf?"
- 3. Child responds with a time e.g. 7 o'clock.
- 4. Adult then moves forwards 7 steps.
- 5. Repeat for a different time until adult reaches child and child turns and says, "Dinner time!"
- 6. Change over to take on different roles.

You can try to make your own owl model using different resources you have, or you can collect some leaves/feathers in your daily walks. Talk to your child about the different parts of the owl's body.















## Day Five

## Here is a sound mat to help you.

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
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
