



Theme: Who are we?

During this half term we will be investigating The Tudors and how they were linked to Hertfordshire. In **Geography** we will be locating royal homes and palaces on a map of the United Kingdom. In **History**, we will be researching Henry VIII and his reign. In **English** lessons we will be reading the book 'Treason', in which our writing outcomes will be based. 

How do they differ from nowadays?</p> 	<p>Tudor houses are very distinctive. Can you research what they look like and what they were made from. Draw a detailed picture or create a model of a Tudor house.</p> 	<p>Create a board game that will help you to practice your times tables.</p> 
<p>Write a book review of a book you have recently read. Think about what the story is about and why you like it.</p> 	<p>Go on a walk, in the woods, local park or somewhere new! Make a record of the wildlife you see! Then can you research a bit about each insect or animal to make a fact file?</p> 	<p>Research Cassiobury House (it was demolished many years ago). What links did it have to The Tudors? Create a fact file from your findings.</p> 	<p>Create a diagram which shows the life cycle of a human being. Now create a diagram which shows the life cycle of an animal of your choice. What is similar/different about them?</p> 	<p>Record the physical activity you do every week. Do you think you do enough? If not, go for a bike ride, scooter around the block or try jogging (you'll soon get your steps up!).</p> 
<p>Can you create a poster that promotes internet safety and what you should do to remain safe online?</p> 	<p>Discover where you live! Go on an adventure around your local area. Draw and list 10 interesting things that you have found.</p> 	<p>In Henry VIII's court everyone enjoyed huge banquets. Create a Tudor dinner menu fit for a King! Remember to include a starter, main and dessert.</p> 	<p>The Mary Rose was an important Tudor battleship. She was built in 1511 but sank in 1545. How did she sink? Can you make a model of the Mary Rose that will float?</p> 	<p>Can you create a poster or leaflet about Spain? Research what food is eaten, landmarks, cities etc.</p>
