

## Theme: Is it really that different in Manaus?

During this half term we will be investigating 'Is it really that different in Manaus?' In geography we will comparing Manaus and Watford, exploring the physical features including the Amazon River and in science we will learn about the parts of a plant and how they reproduce. Our writing will link to the story 'Journey to the River Sea', writing a diary entry in role, followed by an explanation text linked to our Science learning. We will continue exploring angles in Maths, as well as recapping formal methods of multiplication and division and our focus will be Sikhism in RE. In Spanish, our topic is Que tiempo hace?- What is the weather?, and in PSHE we will be learning about healthy relationships with the internet.

This home learning sheet will be sent home each half term with various 'menu' activities for you to work
through and some daily tasks too (listed below).
Spellings will be sent home weekly to ensure you have the challenges you need to become a super speller!
