## Theme: How creative were the Egyptians?

During this half term we will be investigating the world of Ancient Egypt. To understand this we will be travelling back in time to uncover the mysteries and creativity of these people who lived 5,000 years ago. In Science we are investigating sustainabily and caring for our environment. English will reflect these fields of study through the book Weslandia, poetry and newspaper reports.

Reading	Daily	Please read at home daily. This could be a shared read with a member of your family, an opportunity for you to read to an adult in your family as well as time to quietly read and enjoy a good book on your own. Please record all reading in your reading record and bring this to the school daily. We expect this to be signed four times.			
Maths	Daily	In Year 3, children should practise the 3, 4 and 8 times tables up to 12 x 3, 4 and 8 and corresponding division facts (e.g. 24 ÷ 4 = 6). You can use chanting, singing, copying out the tables or practise using online games and apps. They must complete 30 minutes on TTRS each week.
