



**Theme: How has land use changed in Leavesden?**

During this half term we will be exploring who we are. We are investigating land use changes in Leavesden and the development of flight. In Science this term we are learning all about the human body. We will investigate what diet we need to be healthy and how bones and muscles work. Our book for English this term is War and Peas - a fable about two kings. We will also be reading The Queen's Nose in our Reading lessons, a fun story about a magical coin and some wishes. We have so many great things planned to do with the children during this first term in Year 3 and are looking forward to learning together!

<b>Reading</b>	Daily	Please read at home daily. This could be a shared read with a member of your family, an opportunity for you to read to an adult in your family as well as time to quietly read and enjoy a good book on your own. Please record all reading in your reading record and bring this to the school daily. We expect this to be read four times.
<b>Maths</b>	Daily	In Year 3, children should practise the 3, 4 and 8 times tables up to 12 x 3, 4 and 8 and corresponding division facts (e.g. $24 \div 4 = 6$ ). You can use chanting, singing, copying out the tables or practise using online games and apps. <b>Spelling</b>	Daily	Look at the spelling list and practise the spellings. Put these spellings into sentences each week and practice for your test. When reading look out for words with our spelling pattern and add them to the list. Use your home learning book to practise your spellings.
<b>Handwriting</b>	Whenever you're writing in your Home Learning book	Use your spelling homework to practise your best handwriting. Remember to use an appropriate writing utensil (e.g. sharp pencil or black biro pen).

Familiarise and create your own comic strip adventure.</p> 	<p><b>Cheeseboard (PSHE/PE)</b></p> <p>Bake something delicious to share with your family. You may need some help with this. Take a picture of you doing it.</p> 
<p>Write a big list of words that start with the first letter of your name.</p> 	<p>Create addition and subtraction sentences using materials from the outdoors (e.g. sticks, leaves, pebbles).</p> 	<p>Find out at least five facts about Leavesden.</p> 	<p>Create a piece of artwork inspired by the trees around. You cannot use pencils, crayons, paints or chalks.</p> 	<p>Explore where you live by going for walk and list at least ten things you see around you. What do they tell us about the place we live in?</p> 
<p>Choose a book that you love to read and write a review about it.</p> 	<p>Plan out a healthy menu. Think about what you will include, for a day, and why. Be sure that you include your five a day.</p> 	<p>Some of the aerodrome in Leavesden is now the home of the Harry Potter Studios. Create a leaflet about the studios encouraging people to visit.</p> 	<p>Find a perfect pebble and paint it using your great imagination.</p> 	<p>Invent a game using a ball.
