- Work with our teachers to support children's learning.
- Attend Parent Evenings to discuss children's work and progress.
- Ensure that children engage in home learning projects (including contributing to Tapestry for EYFS) and hands them when required.
- Support the school in maintaining good behaviour and discipline.
- Work collaboratively with teachers to resolve any issues which might arise.
- If you have any concerns, to raise them in an appropriate way which follows our school communications procedure.
