

BRASS LESSONS AT CHERRY TREE SCHOOL

Dear Parents/Guardians,

My name is Mr Giovanni Re, a Brass Instrument Tutor/Educator with more than fifteen years experience, teaching in primary and secondary schools. I have tutored students from beginner to advanced level, taking them through the ABRSM -Trinity exams, and supporting through to auditions for the Junior Music Department of the London Music Colleges.

My background as a teacher and freelance trumpet player has led to my brass classes being based on various basic techniques/skills adapted to the student's needs to enhance their musical understanding and confidence. This includes: breathing, embouchure setting, music notation reading, posture/holding the instrument correctly, sound production and exam preparation. I help students to aim high, in addition to having fun and enjoyment.

Lessons Options:

10 Lessons per term

1) 30 minutes small groups 3-5 Pupils- £100 per student

2) 20 minutes individual lesson one to one - £150 per student

Initially an instrument can be borrowed to use (in school only) until you are able to purchase your own, under the school terms and conditions. The only other equipment needed is a notebook.

Once you have signed up for lessons, parents can arrange to use a spare room after school for 30 minutes to supervise practise sessions, using borrowed school instruments as instruments can't be taken out of school.
