- Bite from an insect
- Dropping heavy wood
- Splinters from wood
- Trips from obstacles

Outdoor Learning Garden Hazards



Log Circle

- Tripping over logs
- Splinters from wood
- Dropping heavy wood on feet
- Scratches on legs from wood

Outdoor Learning Garden Hazards



Water Butt

- Trips and falling over obstacles
- Dirty water - infections

Construction Zone

- Lifting heavy objects
- Dropping heavy objects
- Splinters from wood
- Trips from obstacles
- Falling from constructions

Wildlife Garden Hazards



Pathways

- Bite from an insects
- Splinters from wood
- Trips from obstacles such as rock edging.
- Scratches from overhanging branches

Wildlife Garden Hazards



Pond Area

- Bite from an insects
- Splinters from wood
- Trips from obstacles such as rock benches.
- Scratches from overhanging branches
- Slipping on wet concrete into pond

Wildlife Garden Hazards



Pathways

- Splinters from wood
- Trips from obstacles such as wooden edging.
- Scratches from overhanging branches
- Stings from plants or scratches from thorny plants

Wildlife Garden Hazards



Log Piles

- Bite from an insects
- Splinters from wood
- Trips from obstacles
- Scratches from overhanging branches
- Poking eyes from lifting large branches

Wildlife Garden Hazards



Pond and Bridge

- Bite from an insects
- Drowning from pond
- Trips from obstacles such as rock edging.
- Infection from dirty water
- Slipping on wet mud into pond

Wildlife Garden Hazards



Pathways

- Scratches from overhanging branches
- Cuts from thorns or spikey plants

Edible Garden Hazards



- Bite or sting from an insects
- Splinters from wood
- Trips from tools left on ground
- Cut hands or feet from sharp tools
- Sting or scratch from prickly plants

- Bumping into another child

- Wet or slippery bars
- Wet wood
