Home Learning:	Communication and Language Expectations:
Please practise: Nursery – Independence Skills – • Coat on and off • Putting shoes and socks on and off • Using a knife and fork and cutting food • Independently go to the toilet Reception - • Name writing independently. • Letter formation. • Continue to practice and learn phonic sounds. • Blending sounds to read words. • Write CVC words e.g. cat, dog and then challenge to write a caption e.g. a red bus. • To recognise and make numbers 0-10 in different ways for example, counting cubes/toys and making marks e.g. dots. • Taking notice in changes in the environment around you. Please see attached homework for the half term holidays.	• Get the child's attention • Build on what the child says to you • Give the child time to respond (10 seconds) • Imitate the child's language • Use the full range of expressions • Make learning language fun • Use all the senses to help teach new words • Use simple repetitive language • Rather than criticise, demonstrate the right way
