<p>Home Learning:</p> <p>Please practise:</p> <p>Nursery – Independence Skills –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coat on and off • Putting shoes and socks on and off • Using a knife and fork and cutting food • Independently go to the toilet <p>Reception -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name writing independently. • Letter formation. • Continue to practice and learn phonic sounds. • Blending sounds to read words. • Write CVC words e.g. cat, dog and then challenge to write a caption e.g. a red bus. • To recognise and make numbers 0-10 in different ways for example, counting cubes/toys and making marks e.g. dots. • Taking notice in changes in the environment around you e.g notice changes in seasons or the number of objects seen. <p>Please see attached homework for the half term holidays.</p>	<p>Communication and Language Expectations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get the child’s attention • Build on what the child says to you • Give the child time to respond (10 seconds) • Imitate the child’s language • Use the full range of expressions • Make learning language fun • Use all the senses to help teach new words • Use simple repetitive language • Rather than criticise, demonstrate the right way

<p>We will be focusing on listening, retelling and re-writing story books, including The Three Little Pigs, Jack and the Beanstalk, Goldilocks and the Three Bears and The Three Billy Goats Gruff.</p>
