On Monday, we welcome Mrs Cooper to our admin team, working in the School Office. Thanks to Mrs Shah who has been helping out in the interim.

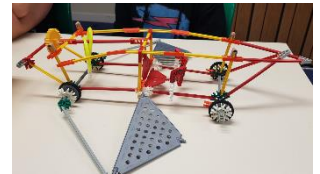
Year 5 - World War 2 Day
