Dear Parents/Carers

Further to the announcement that Ms Bruce will be retiring at the end of the Summer term, I am delighted to confirm that Miss Cheska Tyler has been appointed as Headteacher of Cherry Tree School, joining us from the beginning of September. Cheska has been Assistant Headteacher at Newington Green Primary School in Islington for the past four and a half years, having previously taught at the school as well as in another school in Brighton. Cheska is a keen runner, food blogger and enjoys travelling.

We chose Cheska after an extensive assessment process that included panel interviews, informal discussions, a formal presentation, a lesson observation, a data exercise and meeting parents and children from Cherry Tree. We will say much more about this at a later date, but while welcoming Cheska, I must also personally thank Jess Bruce for her long and successful career as Headteacher of Cherry Tree School. Jess and Cheska will be collaborating over the coming weeks and months to ensure the smoothest possible handover. Clearly these are unusual times but when they are over, I look forward to celebrating Jess' extensive career in the proper way and welcoming Cheska as the new Headteacher of Cherry Tree School
