<p>Write a book review of a book you have recently read. Think about what the story is about and why you like it.</p> 	<p>Record the physical activity you do every week. Do you think you do enough? If not, go for a bike ride, scoot around the block or try jogging (you'll soon get your steps up!).</p> 	<p>Research Cassiobury House. What links does it have to The Tudors? Create a fact file from your findings.</p> 	<p>Create a diagram which shows the life cycle of a human being. Now create a diagram which shows the life cycle of an animal of your choice.
